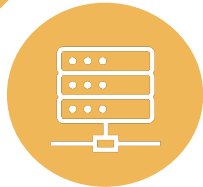

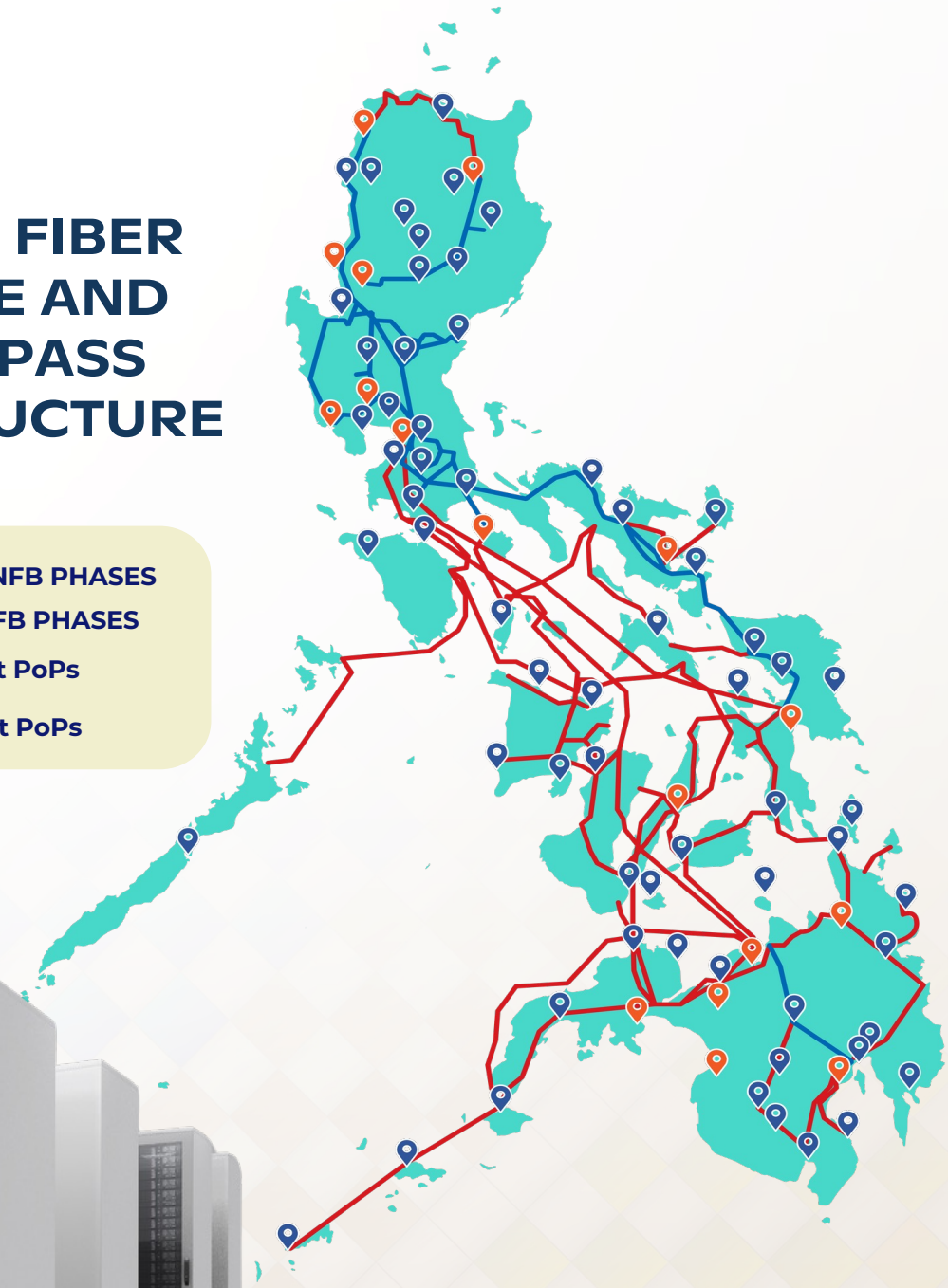

Passage of the CADENA Act

Target: 2Q 2026

- Mandates disclosure of documents across the national budget cycle
- Utilize blockchain technology to ensure immutable, transparent, and decentralization of documents.



Expansion of eGOV_{PH} and eLGU Target: 2026

- 40M App downloads
- 200+ eLGUs integrated with eGovPay
- 1,200+ Local and National Government Services



Launch of the National Single Window

Target: 2Q 2026

- Unified digital platform that aims to streamline and digitize processes for import, export, and trade-related regulatory requirements.
- Ensures transparency through data submission across relevant trade agencies, facilitating easier tracking and processing of documents.
