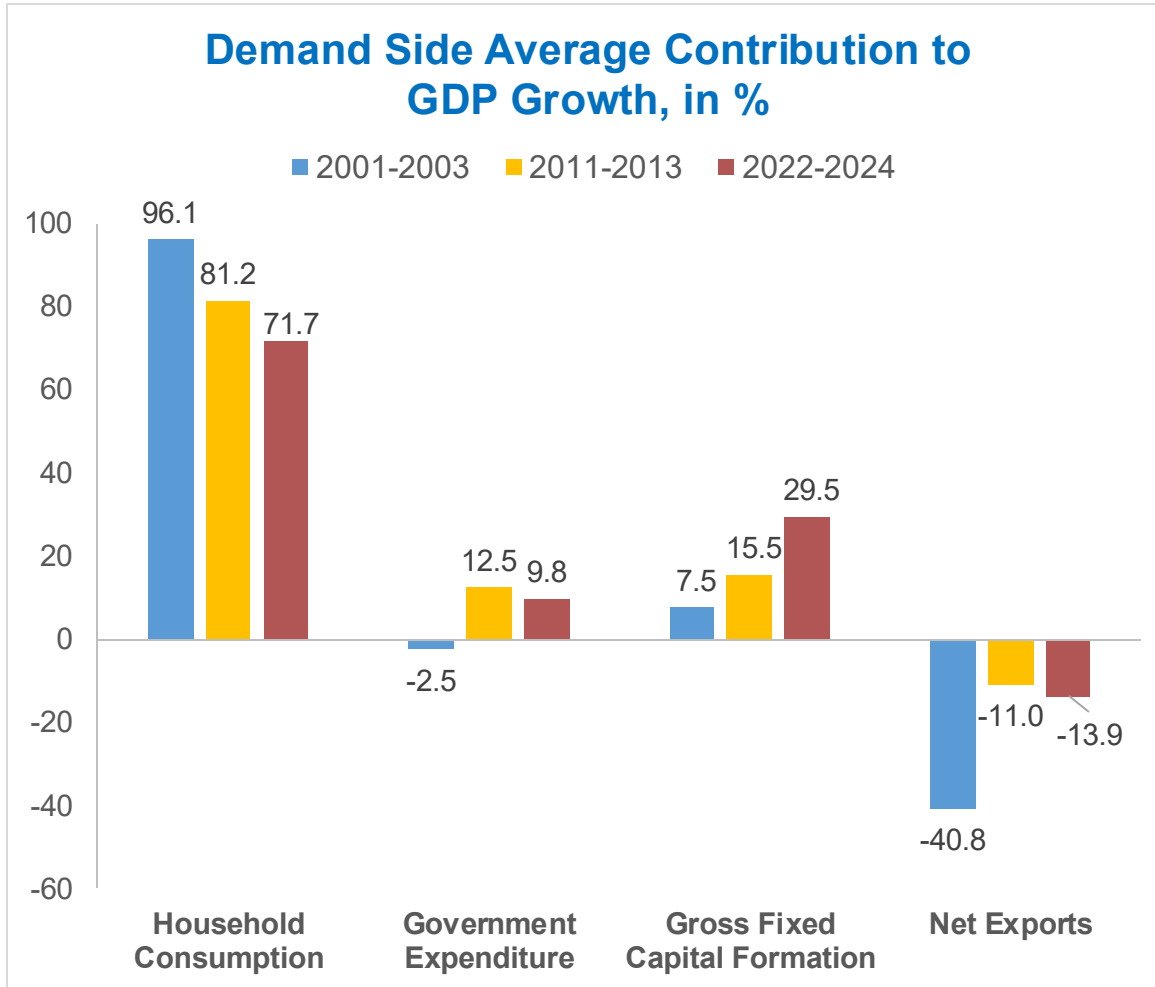

Reinforcing other growth pillars of the Philippine economy.

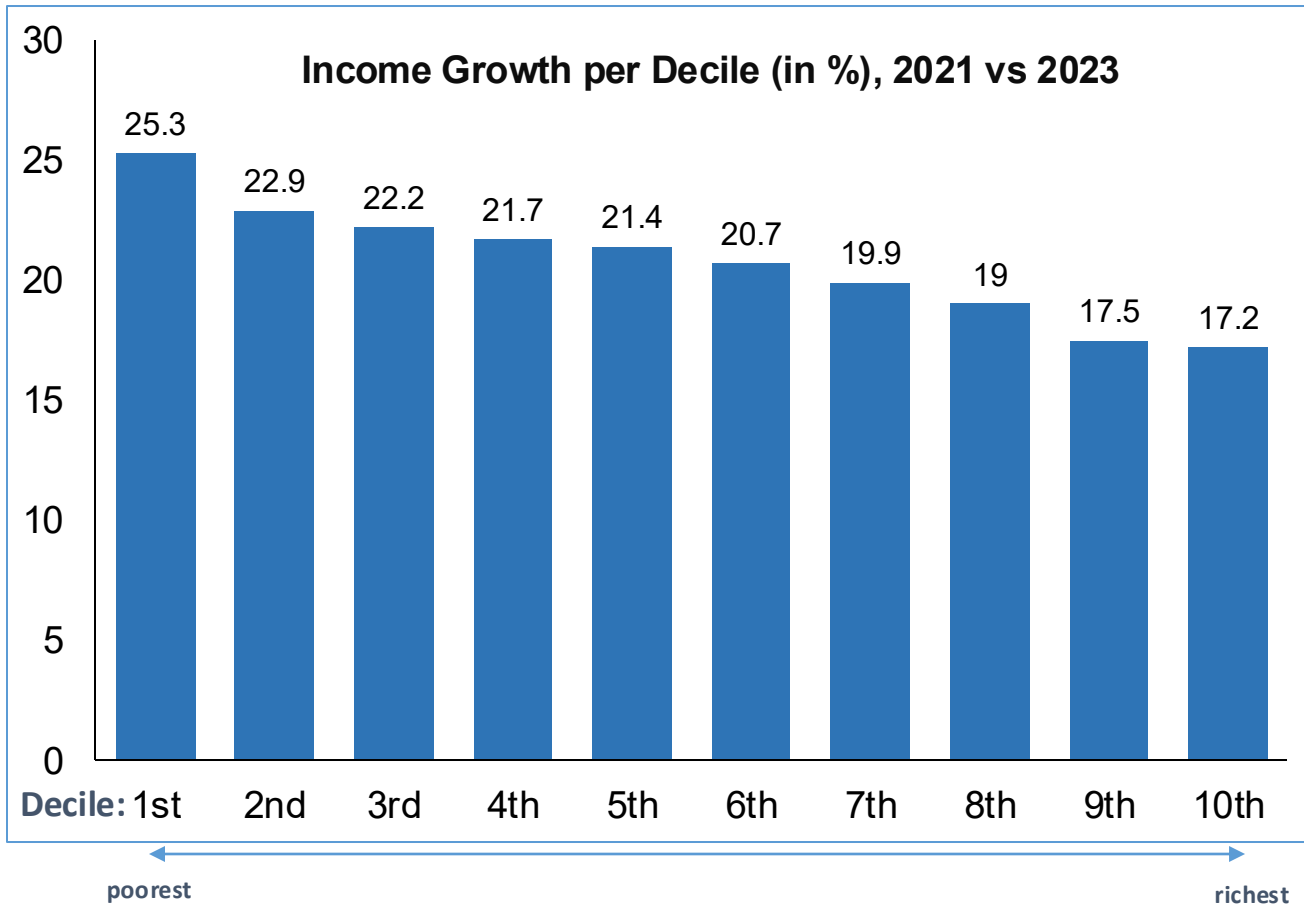


Sustain Public Investments, Enhance Environment for Private Investments, Widen Trade Opportunities, Enhance Resilience

- Upgrade infrastructure (5% of GDP, PPPs for connectivity)
- Create a more competitive and investor-friendly business environment
- Diversify FTAs and support export-oriented sectors
- Strengthen disaster and climate resilience.
