


Flood Management Program



Panay-Guimaras-Negros Island Bridges Project

Description: Construction of 32.47 km – 2 sea-crossing bridges including connecting roads and interchanges that will connect – the islands of Panay, Guimaras and Negros.

Project Impact: Travel time from Panay Island to Negros Island will be shortened from the current 3-4 hour - shipping to about 1 hour by vehicles through the interlink bridges including passing the Guimaras Island. Will benefit around 6,589 – 8,047 travelers per day.

Project Cost: Php 187.53 Billion

Funding Source: Proposed for ODA Financing

Schedule (Civil Works): Dec. 2025- Nov. 2030

Status: Ongoing procurement of the Consulting Services for DED and Tender Assistance .



Metro Cebu Expressway

Length: 56.9 kms.

Project Cost: Php 95.94 Billion

Funding Source: Locally Funded and PPP

Schedule: 2018-2031

Status: Construction of 4.55 kilometer road section is on-going under local funds, while the other segments are proposed for PPP.



Cebu-Mactan Bridge (4th Bridge) and Coastal Road Construction Project

Length: 8.68 kms.

Project Cost: Php 76.41 Billion

Funding Source: JICA PH-P274

Schedule: June 2024-December 2028

Status: DED Plans for approval.



Panglao-Tagbilaran City Offshore Bridge Connector

Length: 2.71 kms.

Project Cost: Php 6.96 Billion

Funding Source: GOP and China Grant

Schedule: 2018-2026

Status; On-going construction of approach road using local funds.



2nd San Juanico Bridge Project

Length: 4.85 kms.

Project Cost: Php 12.80 Billion

Funding Source: Proposed for JICA Loan

Schedule: 2026-2028

Status: For Feasibility Study
