



Davao City Bypass Construction Project

Description: Construction of a 4 lane – 45.46 km highway, including 2-2.3 km mountain tunnels, 2-Cut & Cover Tunnel (315 m & 130 m) at Cabantian Intersection and a 600 m underpass along Davao-Bukidnon Road Intersection.

Project Impact: Travel time between Brgy. Sirawan in Toril District Davao City and Brgy. J.P. Laurel in Panabo City will be reduced from 1 hour and 44 minutes to 49 minutes and will benefit around 15,781 travelers per day.

Project Cost: Php 46.81 Billion
